CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

- Any Trustee/Director who has a financial interest in a matter under discussion should declare the nature of their interest and withdraw from the room unless they have a dispensation to speak.
- If a Trustee/Director has an interest in a matter under discussion which creates a real danger of bias, that is, the interest affects them or a member of their household or more generally they or a member of their household would be affected by the decision, they should declare the nature of the interest and withdraw from the room, unless they have a dispensation to speak.
- If a Trustee/Director has any other interest which does not create a real danger of bias but which might reasonably cause others to think it could influence their decision, they should declare the nature of the interest but may, if they wish to do so, remain in the room, take part in the discussion and vote.
- If in any doubt about the application of these rules, the Trustee should consult with the chair.
- On joining the Trust, a Trustee should complete the following Declaration of Interest Form and update this on an annual basis.
